Health Insurance Administrator Jonne Slemmons said that she spoke to John Joe in December to get quotes from different insurance companies.

John Joe got six quotes and Administrator Jonne Slemmons reviewed the plans and picked three plans.

Administrator Jonne Slemmons was looking to reduce the City's premiums and get better benefits for the employees.

The Midwest Public Risk has two proposals on deductibles which are \$1,000.00 or \$1,500.00, with co-pays of \$30.00 for office call and \$50.00 for specialist. Administrator Jonne Slemmons was notified that Federated Insurance would be increased by 6% - 10%.

John Joe explained the current insurance plan the City has with Federated Insurance, the employees get no benefits until all the deductible is met.

Doreen Hull, Midwest Public Risk representative, answered some questions about prescriptions, lab work, doctors and hospital in network.

Doreen Hull, Midwest Public Risk representative told employees that the new product since we left is called Powertrain. Powertrain is where you can facetime a nurse for minor sickness, like pink eye or bronchitis and the cost would be \$40.00.

Alderman Lance Johns asked the employees if they liked the new plan better and the response was yes.
